Dear Parents and Carers,

Financial circumstances for many families have changed over the last few months. If this is the case, you may be eligible for Pupil Premium funding.

The Pupil Premium is extra money given to your child's school to spend on resources such as one to one or group tutoring, music lessons, extra-curricular clubs and school trips. For 2021/22 we believe this will be **£1345 per pupil**. Funding is based on children registered for a free school meal, further reinforcing the importance of making sure all those who qualify are actually registered.

Please use the link to apply if your income meets one of the categories below.

Your child may be entitled to receive free school meals if you are entitled to receive one of the following:



- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
